SBA DECLARATION #10211 -- MILITARY RESERVIST ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOAN PROGRAM.

Small businesses employing military reservists may apply for economic injury disaster loans if those employees are called up to active duty during a period of military conflict existing on or after March 24, 1999 and those employees are essential to the success of the small business daily operations. The filing period for small businesses to apply for economic injury loan assistance under the Military Reservist Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program begins on the date the essential employee is ordered to active duty and ends on the date 90 days after the essential employee is discharged or released from active duty.

To date, SBA has approved \$30,700.

SBA DECLARATION #10466/10467 – FIRE AT THE COUNTRY CLUB ESTATES CONDOMINIUM COMPLEX THAT OCCURRED APRIL 15, 2006.

Small businesses located in counties of Hillsborough and Rockingham may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. These counties are eligible because they are contiguous to one or more primary counties in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is February 16, 2007.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications expired July 17, 2006.

SBA DECLARATION #10336 – EXCESSIVE RAIN, HIGH WINDS, FLOODING AND FLASH FLOODING THAT OCCURRED OCTOBER 7, 2005 AND CONTINUING.

Small businesses located in Fairfield and Litchfield counties may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance through the SBA. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. Physical damages cannot be covered by these loans. These counties are eligible because they are contiguous to one or more primary counties in the State New York.

Only small, non-farm agriculture dependent businesses and small agricultural cooperatives are eligible to apply for assistance. Nurseries are also eligible for economic injury caused by drought conditions.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is September 11, 2006.

SBA DECLARATION #10299/10300 – SEVERE FLOODING THAT OCCURRED OCTOBER 14-15, 2005.

Small businesses located in Hartford, Litchfield and Tolland counties and contiguous counties of Fairfield, Middlesex, New Haven, New London and Windham may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. To date, SBA has approved \$5,777,800 in disaster loans as a result of this disaster.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is September 21, 2006.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications expired March 23, 2006.

SBA DECLARATION #10257 – SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED OCTOBER 7-16, 2005.

Small businesses located in the counties of Hartford, Litchfield, Tolland and Windham may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. These counties are eligible because they are contiguous to one or more primary counties declared in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is August 10, 2006.
