SBA DECLARATION #10211 -- MILITARY RESERVIST ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOAN PROGRAM.

Small businesses employing military reservists may apply for economic injury disaster loans if those employees are called up to active duty during a period of military conflict existing on or after March 24, 1999 and those employees are essential to the success of the small business daily operations.

The filing period for small businesses to apply for economic injury loan assistance under the Military Reservist Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program begins on the date the essential employee is ordered to active duty and ends on the date 90 days after the essential employee is discharged or released from active duty.

To date, SBA has approved \$260,300 in disaster loans.

SBA DECLARATION #10437/10438 – TORNADOES AND SEVERE STORMS THAT OCCURRED MARCH 11, 2006 THROUGH MARCH 13, 2006.

Homeowners, renters, landlords, businesses and nonprofit organizations located in Greene, Morgan and Sangamon County are eligible to apply for physical damage disaster loans. Small businesses in Greene, Morgan and Sangamon and contiguous counties of Brown, Calhoun, Cass, Christian, Jersey, Logan, Macon, Macoupin, Menard, Montgomery, Pike and Scott also eligible to apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. To date, SBA has approved \$984,200 in disaster loans as a result of this disaster.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications is May 30, 2006.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is December 28, 2006.

SBA DECLARATION #10429 – SEVERE STORMS, TORNADOES AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED MARCH 8-13, 2006.

Small businesses located in Alexander, Calhoun, Jackson, Monroe, Randolph and Union counties may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. This county is eligible because it is contiguous to one or more primary counties in the State of Missouri.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is December 15, 2006.
