SBA DECLARATION #10211 -- MILITARY RESERVIST ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOAN PROGRAM.

Small businesses employing military reservists may apply for economic injury disaster loans if those employees are called up to active duty during a period of military conflict existing on or after March 24, 1999 and those employees are essential to the success of the small business daily operations.

The filing period for small businesses to apply for economic injury loan assistance under the Military Reservist Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program begins on the date the essential employee is ordered to active duty and ends on the date 90 days after the essential employee is discharged or released from active duty.

To date, SBA has approved \$1,281,700 in disaster loans.

SBA DECLARATION #10486/10487 – TORNADOES AND SEVERE STORMS OCCURRED MAY 25, 2006.

Homeowners, renters, landlords, businesses and nonprofit organization located in Pike County and contiguous counties of Daviess, Dubois, Gibson, Knox and Warrick may apply for physical damage disaster loans. Small businesses may also apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications is August 7, 2006.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is March 8, 2007.

Homeowners, renters, landlords, businesses and nonprofit organization located in Daviess, Lawrence, Orange and Shelby Counties and contiguous counties of Bartholomew, Crawford, Decatur, Dubois, Greene, Hancock, Jackson, Johnson, Knox, Marion, Martin, Monroe, Pike, Rush and Washington may apply for physical damage disaster loans. Small businesses may also apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications is June 12, 2006.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is January 16, 2007.

Small businesses located in Daviess County and contiguous counties of Dubois, Greene, Knox, Martin and Pike may apply for physical damage disaster loans. Small businesses may also apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. To date, SBA has approved \$1,097,400 in disaster loans as a result of this disaster.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is October 4, 2006.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications expired March 6, 2006.

Small businesses located in Posey, Vanderburgh and Warrick counties may apply for physical damage disaster loans. Small businesses may also apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. These counties are eligible because they are contiguous to one or more primary counties in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is September 16, 2006.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications expired February 14, 2006.

These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. To date, SBA has approved \$1,052,500 in disaster loans as a result of this disaster.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is August 8, 2006.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications expired January 9, 2006.
