SBA DECLARATION #10211 -- MILITARY RESERVIST ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOAN PROGRAM.

Small businesses employing military reservists may apply for economic injury disaster loans if those employees are called up to active duty during a period of military conflict existing on or after March 24, 1999 and those employees are essential to the success of the small business daily operations.

The filing period for small businesses to apply for economic injury loan assistance under the Military Reservist Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program begins on the date the essential employee is ordered to active duty and ends on the date 90 days after the essential employee is discharged or released from active duty.

To date, SBA has approved \$202,300 in disaster loans.

SBA DECLARATION #10429 – SEVERE STORMS, TORNADOES AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED MARCH 8-13, 2006.

Small businesses located in Ballard, Carlisle, Fulton and Hickman Counties may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. This county is eligible because it is contiguous to one or more primary counties in the State of Missouri.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is December 15, 2006.

SBA DECLARATION #10294/10295 – SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED NOVEMBER 15-29, 2005.

Small businesses located in Henderson County and contiguous counties of Daviess, McLean, Union and Webster may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. To date, SBA has approved \$373,700 in disaster loans as a result of this disaster.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is September 16, 2006.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications expired February 14, 2006.
