### **SBA DECLARATION #10211 -- MILITARY RESERVIST ECONOMIC INJURY DISASTER LOAN PROGRAM.**

Small businesses employing military reservists may apply for economic injury disaster loans if those employees are called up to active duty during a period of military conflict existing on or after March 24, 1999 and those employees are essential to the success of the small business daily operations. The filing period for small businesses to apply for economic injury loan assistance under the Military Reservist Economic Injury Disaster Loan Program begins on the date the essential employee is ordered to active duty and ends on the date 90 days after the essential employee is discharged or released from active duty.

### **SBA DECLARATION #10478/10477 – SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED MAY 12, 2006.**

Homeowners, renters, landlords, businesses and nonprofit organizations located in Belknap, Carroll, Hillsborough, Merrimack, Rockingham and Strafford counties may apply for physical damage disaster loans. Small businesses in the counties named above and in the contiguous counties of Cheshire, Coos, Grafton and Sullivan may also apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications is July 24, 2006.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is February 26, 2007.

### **SBA DECLARATION #10481 – SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED MAY 12, 2006.**

Small businesses located in Hillsborough and Rockingham counties may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. These counties are eligible because they are contiguous to one or more primary counties in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is February 26, 2007.

### **SBA DECLARATION #10479 – SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED MAY 13, 2006.**

Small businesses located in Carroll, Rockingham and Strafford counties may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. These counties are eligible because they are contiguous to one or more primary counties in the State of Maine.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is February 26, 2007.

**SBA DECLARATION #10228/10229 – SEVERE STORMS AND FLOODING THAT OCCURRED OCTOBER 7-18, 2005.**

Small businesses located in the counties of Cheshire, Grafton, Hillsborough, Merrimack and Sullivan and contiguous counties of Belknap, Carroll, Coos, Rockingham and Strafford may apply for economic injury disaster loan assistance. These are working capital loans to help the business continue to meet its obligations until the business returns to normal conditions. To date, SBA has approved \$1,993,000 in disaster loans as a result of this disaster.

The filing deadline for economic injury loan applications is July 26, 2006.

The filing deadline for physical damage loan applications expired December 27, 2005.
