SBA Disaster Loan Outreach Centers in Breathitt, Floyd and Pike Counties to Close July 30

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration announces today that the Disaster Loan Outreach Centers located in Breathitt, Floyd and Pike Counties in the Commonwealth of Kentucky will cease operations **Thursday, July 30 at 1 p.m.**

The Small Business Administration urges those affected by the severe storms, tornadoes, flooding and mudslides that occurred from May 3 through May 20, 2009, to visit the Centers before the closing to obtain one-on-one assistance and information about the disaster assistance program. The SBA also encourages homeowners, renters and businesses who received applications to return their completed applications prior to the July 28 deadline. The filing deadline to return applications for physical property damage is **July 28, 2009**. The deadline to return economic injury applications is **March 1, 2010**.
