SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loan Deadline is May 14

ATLANTA - The U.S. Small Business Administration is reminding small businesses affected by the severe storms and flooding that occurred on Aug. 4, 2009 that the filing deadline is May 14 for Economic Injury Disaster Loans.

Small businesses and most private non-profit organizations in the following counties are eligible to apply for SBA Economic Injury Disaster Loans: Bullitt, Hardin, Jefferson, Oldham, Shelby, Spencer in Kentucky; and Clark, Floyd, and Harrison in Indiana.

Loans are available up to \$2 million for eligible entities that suffered substantial economic injury from the disaster. These working capital loans may be used to pay fixed debts, payroll, accounts payable, and other bills that could have been paid had the disaster not occurred. These loans are not intended to replace lost sales or profits.

The interest rate on these loans is 4 percent, with a maximum term of 30 years. The SBA determines the amount of economic injury and the terms of each loan based on the financial circumstances of the borrower. Eligibility for the program is based on the size and type of business, and its financial resources.

To obtain a loan application, businesses should contact the SBA's Customer Service Center by calling 800-659-2955 (800-877-8339 for the hearing-impaired) Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. EDT, or by sending an e-mail to disastercustomerservice@sba.gov. The deadline for economic injury applications is May 14, 2010.
