## SBA Urges Disaster Victims to Visit the Disaster Loan Outreach Centers

**ATLANTA** – The U. S. Small Business Administration (SBA) urges victims to visit the Disaster Loan Outreach Centers in Carter and Madison counties that were established to assist those impacted by severe storms, flooding and mudslides that occurred on July 17-30, 2010.

To be considered for all forms of disaster assistance, victims are encouraged to register with FEMA by calling 800-621-FEMA (3362) or TTY 800-462-7585 for people with speech or hearing disabilities. The deadline to return SBA loan applications is **Sept. 21**.

“I urged anyone who has not completed their disaster loan application to meet with a Customer Service Representatives at the Centers before they close for one-on-one assistance,” said Frank Skaggs, director of SBA Field Operations Center East in Atlanta.

The filing deadline to return applications for physical property damage is **September 21, 2010**.  
The deadline to return economic injury applications is **April 25, 2011**.
