SBA's Deadline for Economic Injury Disaster Loans for Private Non-Profit Organizations in New York is October 1

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration reminds eligible Private Non-Profit Organizations (PNPs) of the **October 1** deadline to submit disaster loan applications for Economic Injury caused by severe storms and flooding associated with Tropical Depression Ida and a Nor'easter that occurred on November 12-14, 2009.

PNPs located in counties of Nassau and Suffolk in New York are eligible to apply to SBA. Examples of eligible non-critical PNP organizations include, but are not limited to, food kitchens, homeless shelters, museums, libraries, community centers, schools and colleges.

The SBA offers Economic Injury Disaster Loans to help meet working capital needs, such as ongoing operating expenses for PNP organizations of all sizes. Economic Injury Disaster Loan assistance is available regardless of whether the business suffered any physical property damage.

Interest rates are as low as 3 percent with terms up to 30 years. Loan amounts and terms are set by the SBA and are based on each applicant's financial condition.

The deadline to return economic injury applications is **October 1, 2010**.
