SBA Deadline for Economic Injury Disaster Loans to Private Non-Profit Organizations in New Jersey is Nov. 5

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration reminds eligible Private Non-Profit Organizations in New Jersey of the **Nov. 5** deadline to submit disaster loan applications for economic injury due to last winter's snowstorm on Dec. 19 - 20, 2009.

Private Non-Profit Organizations located in Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cumberland, Gloucester, Ocean and Salem counties in New Jersey are eligible to apply for Economic Injury Disaster Loans from the SBA. Examples of eligible non-critical PNP organizations include, but are not limited to, food kitchens, homeless shelters, museums, libraries, community centers, schools and colleges.

The SBA offers Economic Injury Disaster Loans to help meet working capital needs, such as ongoing operating expenses for PNP organizations of all sizes. EIDL assistance is available regardless of whether the organization suffered any physical property damage.

Interest rates are 3 percent with terms up to 30 years. The SBA sets loan amounts and terms based on each applicant's financial condition.

The deadline to return Economic Injury Disaster Loan applications is **Nov. 5, 2010**.
