SBA Disaster Loan Outreach Center in Fairfield County Closing November 6

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration reminds disaster victims that the Disaster Loan Outreach Center in Fairfield County, Connecticut will close **Saturday, Nov. 6 at 5 p.m.**

The Small Business Administration urges those affected by the severe storm and tornado that occurred on June 24, to visit the Center before it closes to obtain one-on-one assistance. The Center is located at:

The SBA offers low interest disaster loans up to \$200,000 for primary residences, \$40,000 in contents for homeowners and renters and \$2 million for physical damage to businesses and non-profits.

SBA also offers Economic Injury Disaster Loans (EIDLs) to help meet working capital needs of small businesses and private non-profit organizations. These loans are available regardless of whether the business suffered any property damage.

The disaster declaration covers the counties of Fairfield, Litchfield, and New Haven in Connecticut; Dutchess, Putnam and Westchester in New York.

The deadline to return SBA applications for physical property damage is **December 17, 2010.** The deadline to return applications for economic injury is **July 18, 2011.**
