SBA's Deadline for Physical Damage Disaster Loan Applications in Connecticut is Dec. 17

ATLANTA – The [U.S. Small Business Administration](#) reminds homeowners, renters, businesses and non-profit organizations located in Connecticut of the deadline to submit disaster loan applications for damage caused by the severe storm and tornado that occurred on June 24, 2010. The deadline to file an [SBA disaster loan](#) application for physical damage is **Dec. 17, 2010**.

Disaster loans are available to homeowners, renters, nonprofit organizations and businesses of all sizes in Fairfield County and the adjacent counties of Litchfield and New Haven in Connecticut; and Dutchess, Putnam and Westchester in New York.

Additionally, anyone with insured losses should not wait for an insurance settlement before applying to the SBA. If they do not know how much of the loss will be covered by insurance or other sources, the SBA will consider making a loan for the total loss up to its loan limits, provided the borrower agrees to use insurance proceeds to reduce or repay their SBA loan.

The SBA offers low interest disaster loans to disaster victims for physical losses. Approved loans can be increased for protective measures to lessen similar future damages. Additionally, small businesses and most private nonprofit organizations can obtain loans for unmet working capital needs.

The filing deadline to return applications for physical damage is **Dec. 17, 2010**. The deadline to return economic injury applications is **July 18, 2011**.
