SBA Opens Disaster Loan Outreach Center In Delaware County Pennsylvania

ATLANTA – The U.S. Small Business Administration announced today that it will open a Disaster Loan Outreach Center at the Community Center – City Hall in Chester, Pennsylvania. The location of the Center makes it convenient for homeowners, renters, businesses and nonprofit organizations of all sizes affected by the severe storms and flooding of September 30 to apply for disaster loan assistance.

“I encourage anyone who has not completed their disaster loan application to meet with one of the Customer Service Representatives at the Center for one-on-one assistance,” said Frank Skaggs, director of SBA’s Field Operations Center East.

The SBA offers low interest disaster loans to disaster victims for physical losses up to its loan limits. Approved loans can be increased for protective measures to lessen similar future damages. Additionally, small businesses and most private nonprofit organizations can obtain loans for unmet working capital needs. To be considered for this assistance, disaster victims need to apply by the deadline.

The deadline to return applications for physical damage is **January 14, 2011**. The deadline to return economic injury applications is **August 15, 2011**.
